Canterbury and Surrey Hills Sports Ovals Saved

The Victorian Government's Rail Crossing Removal Authority recently announced that the Canterbury Sports Oval and the two main ovals at Surrey Park will be untouched by works to remove the dangerous and congested level crossings at Union Road and Mont Albert Road.

Maling Road Heritage Facade Upgrades Have Started

We have recently seen the commencement of Heritage facade maintenance works with Chris and the team at the Good Food Collective abandoning their day to day work tools and taking up the paint brushes. Work completed to date includes replacement of the verandah ironwork and painting of verandah woodwork. The final scope of work to be undertaken includes tile work renovation and a completed coat of paint for the shopfront. Great to see boys!

In addition to the GFC building, we understand that there were also 10 other applications made for the Boroondara Council's Heritage Facade maintenance grants. A majority of applications were for buildings located in Maling road between Scott and Bryson streets. Apart from these buildings, other applications were for buildings on the south side of Maling road between Bryson street and Canterbury road.

We look forward to seeing all of these works being undertaken and look forward to seeing the lifting of the precinct appearance.
