Canterbury Community Precinct Progress - Input Wanted

Many of you will be aware that work is progressing on the development of the new facilities at the Canterbury Community precinct which will be commissioned toward the end of 2022.

Canterbury Neighbourhood Centre being is the principal tenant, with other tenants in the facilities being;

- Canterbury Maternal and Child Health
- Canterbury Norwood Baptist Kindergarten
- Playstation Occasional Care
- Canterbury Toy Library
- Canterbury Community Garden
- Interchange Inner East
- Canterbury History Group, Balwyn and Surrey Hills Historical Societies

As part of planning for their move into the new facilities next year, Canterbury Neighbourhood Centre [CNC] are undertaking a review of their current service provision and will compare these to community needs, thereby identifying opportunities for CNC to improve and where needed increase their community engagement.

As part of this review process CNC are polling a range of friends, stakeholders and community influencers and the broader community in the Canterbury area.
