Additional Commuter Car Parking in Canterbury ! Yes or No.?

Canterbury Community Action Group [CCAG], encourages all community members from our suburb to advise the council and their ward councillors their views either for or against the proposed addition commuter car parking space off Wattle Valley Road.

CCAG will be making a submission on behalf of the Canterbury community and welcome community input, either for and against the proposed carpark . We welcome input / ideas that will optimise community benefit with potential subjects being, but not limited to;

- With an existing commuter carpark adjacent to the station and scarce federal, state, and local government resources, would be it better to improve /expand it with benefit to the Maling road and the adjacent Canterbury road/Rochester road precincts.
- Is the proposed car park in keeping with the unique village feel of Maling Road or will it detract from its character which is one of the reasons people visit the precinct.
- Potential long term effect on trader viability and village ambience with trader loss as result of significant direct and indirect parking losses during construction.
- Impact on traffic congestion management in and around Maling road and other precinct streets.
- More specific, direct negotiations, with the State government for use of non council land.
