Maling Road Place Plan

Initial works involving repaving blue stone in Maling Lane beside the old Post Office building were completed late in September.

Planning is underway for trialing the use of “parklets” in Maling road once lockdown restrictions permit their use. In addition, Council has also begun consultation across Boroondara on the use of footpaths, private and public land for extended outdoor dining.
