Union Road Rail Crossing Removal - Have Your Say!

The State Government propose to remove level crossings at both Union and Mont Albert roads by lowering the Belgrave/Lilydale line into a trench under the roads. The State Government via **Engage Victoria** is surveying local communities [which includes Canterbury, Mont Albert and Surrey Hills] to gauge what are the top three things the communities would like considered with the removal of the level crossings and the building of a new station.

Feedback is sought on a range of planning matters, including:

- Project boundary
- Construction-related impacts
- Environmental impacts
- Amenity impacts
- Native vegetation
- Heritage.

All feedback received will be summarised and included in a consultation report. This report will inform the Minister for Planning's assessment of the project under Clause 52.03.
